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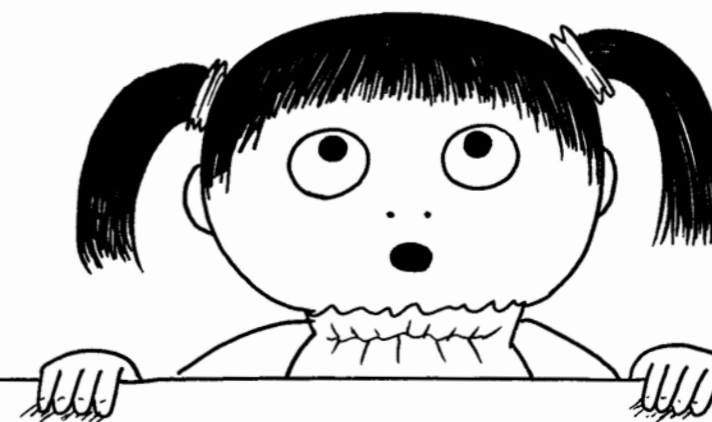
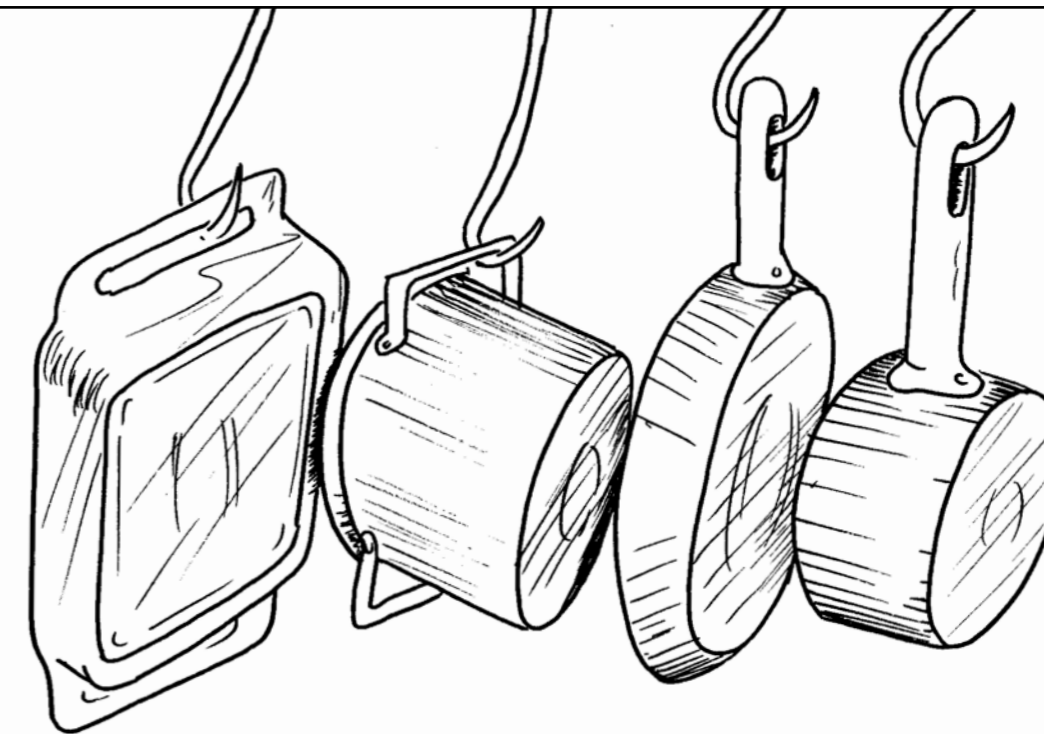
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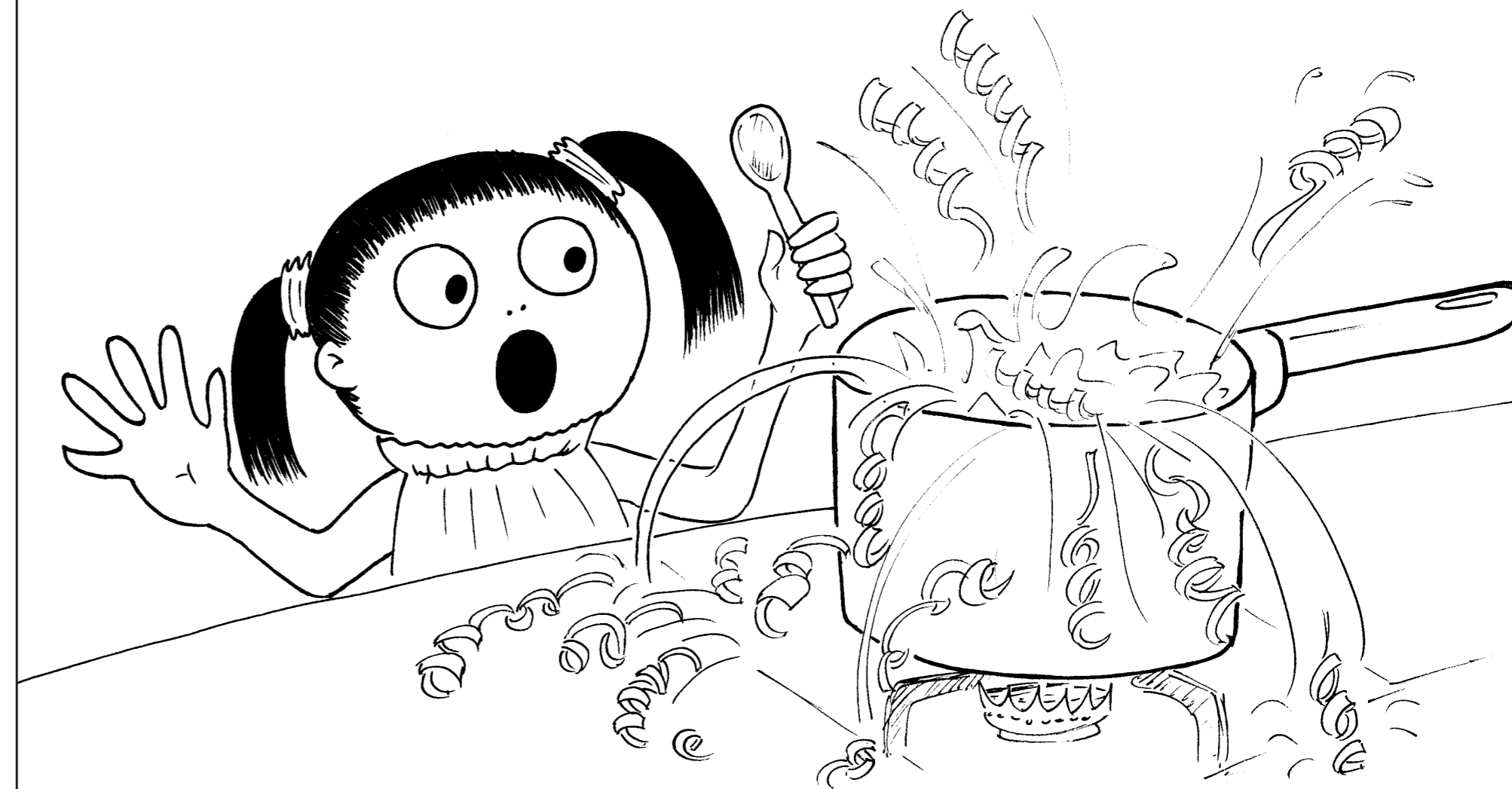
Suzi loved her mum's pasta.

"Which is the best way to cook it?"

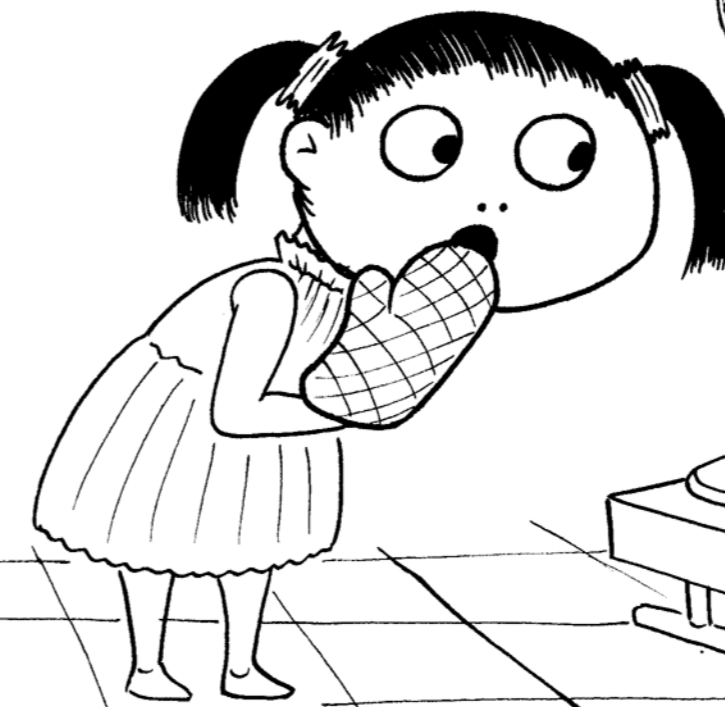


Suzi started with a saucepan of spaghetti.



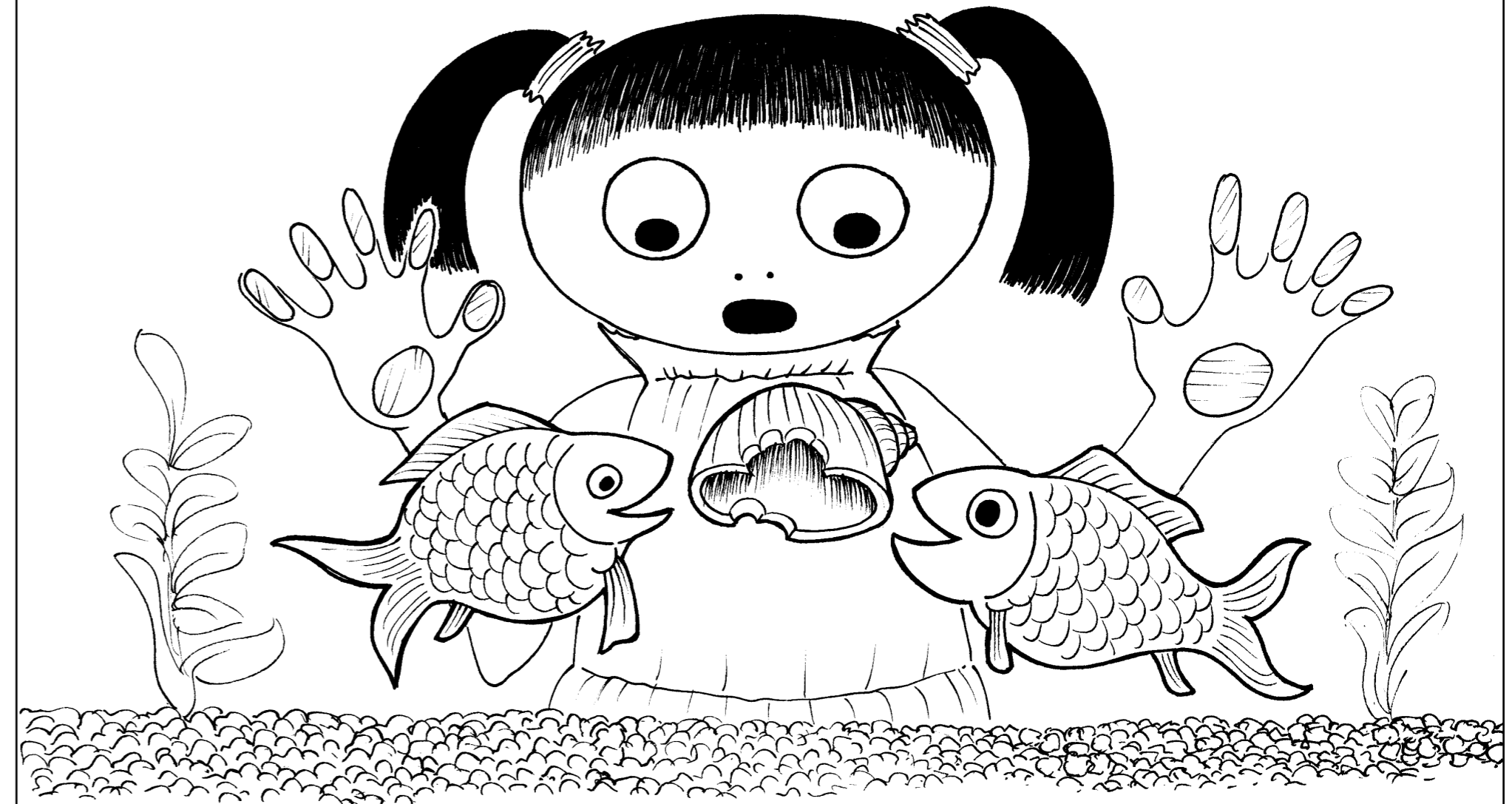
But oh no! It boiled over.

Suzi stuffed the oven with lasagne.



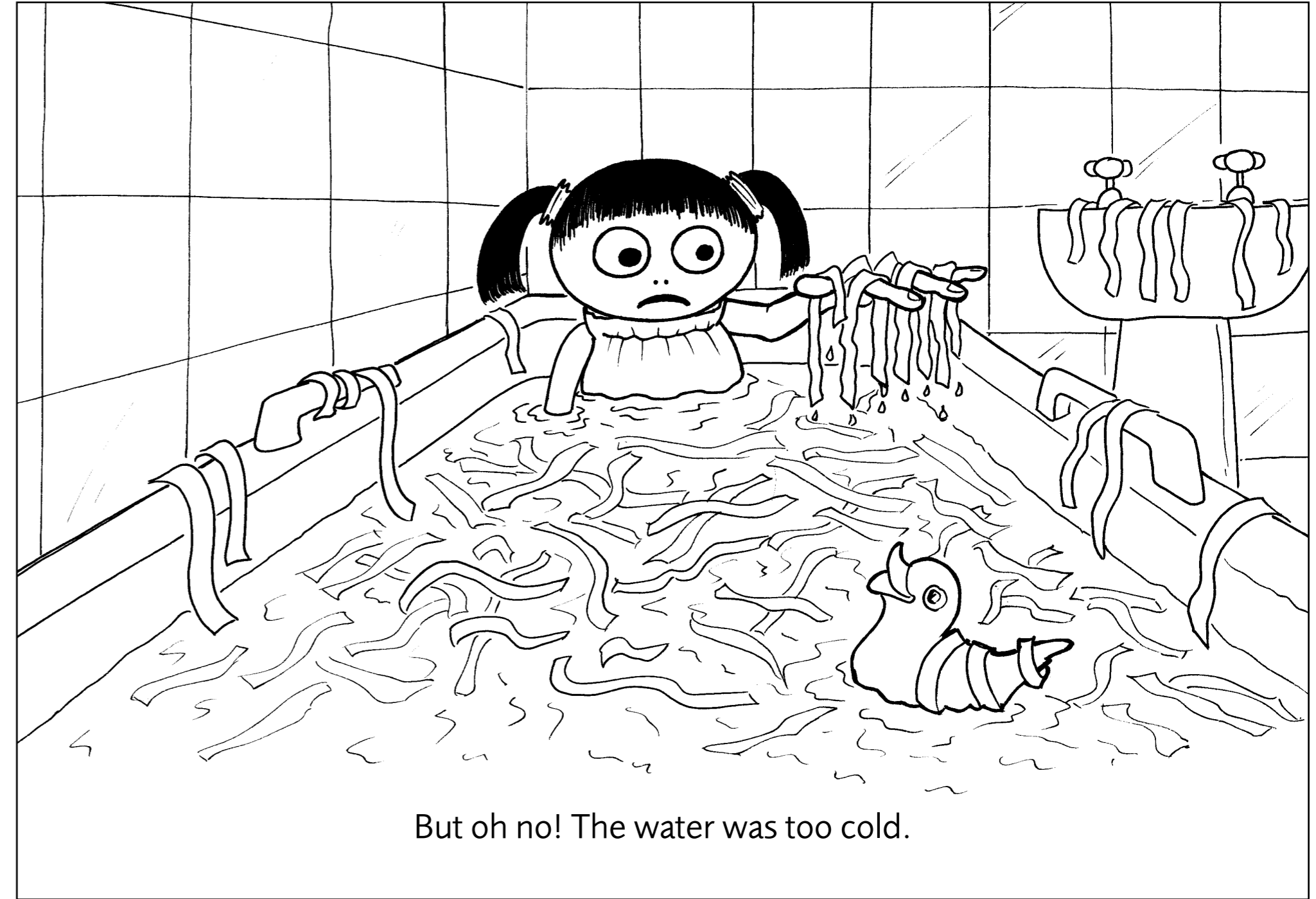
But oh no! It burned.

But oh no! The water was too cold.

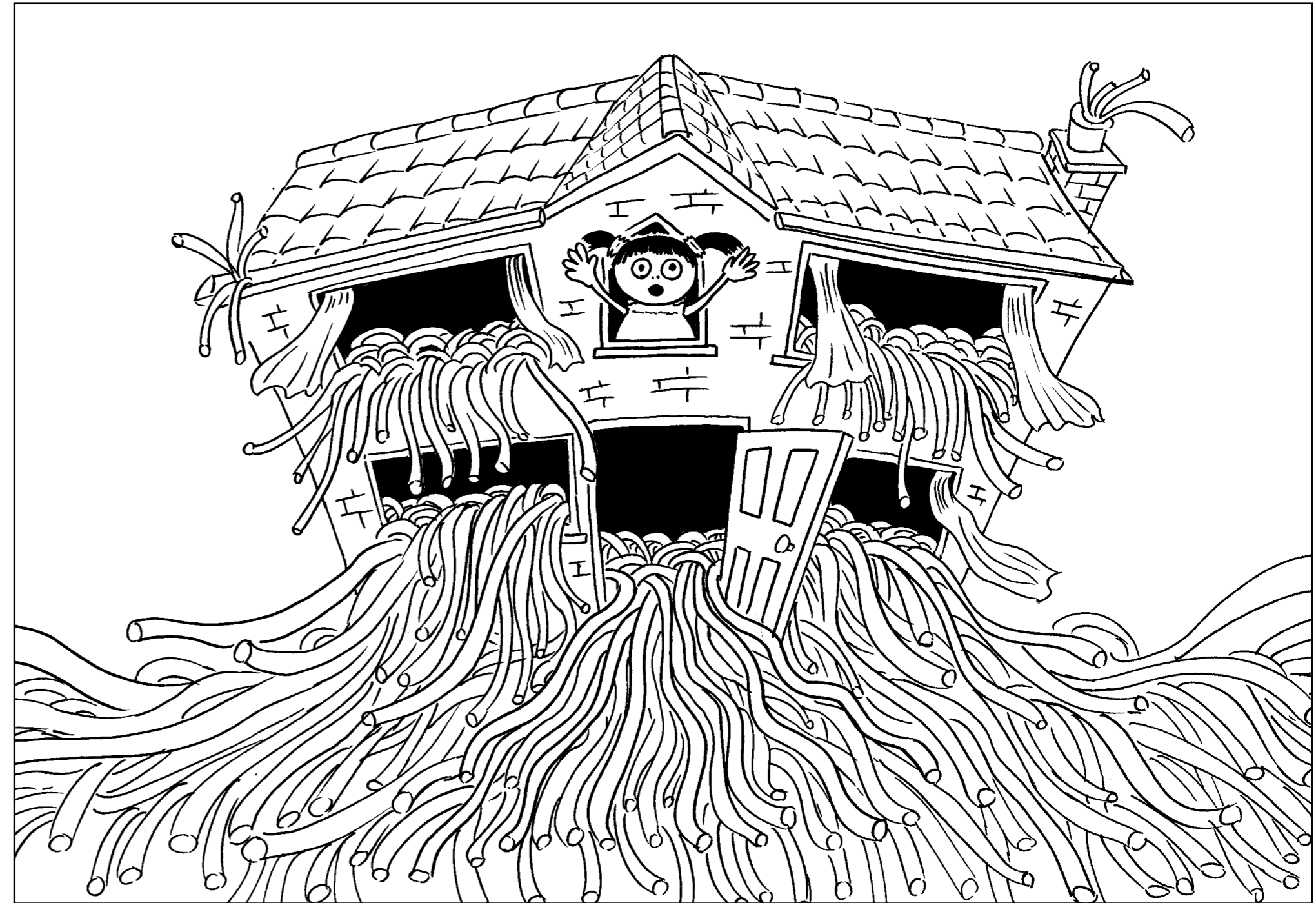
